Directions to Show Site: (GPS will get you lost)

From the east: Take Route 80 west to exit 12. (Hope/Blairstown) Make a left at the end of the ramp. **Go into Hope to the traffic light (approx. 1 mile). Continue straight on 519 and from the light, go exactly 5.8 miles. Building is on the right (Gray building. You will actually see a deep red building before you see the gray one.)

From Route 80 coming EAST (from the Delaware Water Gap Bridge, PA): Route 80 East to Exit 4 B (I think - it is the #4 exit that says Route 46). Get onto route 46 East and go 8 miles. When you get to the light that intersects route 519, (There is actually no sign that says Rt 519, but you will be making a left onto N. Bridgeville Rd, which is Rt 519) make a left and go 4/10 of a mile and make a left into the parking lot at the building.

From the south: (Trenton, Flemington, Washington areas) Take 31 north to the very end. Make a left onto Route 46 west. Go 1.6 miles to the first light and make a right onto route 519. (There is actually no sign that says Rt 519, but you will be making a right onto N. Bridgeville Rd, which is Rt 519) Go 4/10 of a mile and make a left into the parking lot at the building.

From the north: (northern NJ and NY and CT and MA). Take the Tappen Zee Bridge and get onto 287 South (it is south in NJ) and go to exit 41B (I think it is B) and get onto 80 WEST. Take Route 80 west to exit 12. (Hope/Blairstown) Make a left at the end of the ramp. Go into Hope to the traffic light (approx. 1 mile). Continue straight on 519 and from the light, go exactly 5.8 miles. Building is on the right (Gray building. You will actually see a deep red building before you see the gray one.)

From PA (Columbia Portland Bridge): Get off onto Rt 46 east and from the top of the exit ramp, go exactly 8 miles and make a left at the light on the corner of 519 and 46. (There is actually no sign that says Rt 519, but you will be making a left onto N. Bridgeville Rd, which is Rt 519). Go 4/10 of a mile and the building is on the left.

Awards

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog/owner team who achieves a score of 170 or better. Placement rosettes will be awarded to the top 5 high scoring teams in the A Classes. Championship rosettes will be awarded to all teams completing a Championship title.

General Information

Entries will not be accepted without an APDT Rally registration number. To obtain a registration number, please obtain a registration form from the APDT Rally website and mail directly to APDT Rally.

- This is an indoor trial w/ climate control and ¾" rubber matting. Ample crating space. However, there will be no crating ringside. All crating will be in a separate room.
- There will be no food available at this trial
- There will be no refunds for absent entries. Refunds will be made for withdrawn entries only if request is made prior to closing date and can be filled by the waiting list. Refunds will be made if the trials must be cancelled by the host organization due to severe weather. Refunds will be made for bitches in season if request is accompanied by a note from the exhibitor's veterinarian
- Please make checks payable to PMDT.
- No prong or choke collars will be allowed on show grounds.
- **Move ups:** Closing Date for Move ups is November 1, 2010
- There is no distinction between food and non-food classes anymore.
- **There is no handicap access at this site**

Notice to Competitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of APDT Rally Obedience rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- This trial is open to all dogs being at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
- All dogs must be registered with APDT Rally to compete. Forms are available at www.apdt.com.
- Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner's immediate family: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.

In addition,

- THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. There will be no refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- **All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar, plain harness, or properly fitted martingale (limited slip) collar. No choke collar, prong collars, shock collars, no-pull harnesses, martingale leads, or head collars are allowed on the site.**
- All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast, and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the APDT or the trial host(s).
- Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.
- Upon successful completion of an exercise, the owner may choose to briefly pet or touch the dog as a reward. The owner may also choose to give the dog food as a reward. Food may NOT be used as a lure to help the dog complete an exercise. Food rewards must be contained in pockets or hidden treat pouches and only be present in the owner's hand in between exercises. Any petting, touching, or feeding that significantly interrupts the flow of performance shall be scored accordingly.
- Exhibitors that plan to use food as a reward in the ring must indicate that on their entry forms. All teams NOT using food shall be scheduled to compete before those teams using food.
- Dogs must remain under control at all times whether on or off leash while on show grounds. Day kenneling only is permitted, unless otherwise posted at the show site. Crates may be left overnight at your own risk.
- Please pick up after your dog and yourself.
- APDT's official Rally-O Rules and Regulations are hereby incorporated by reference, a copy of which may be obtained by going to APDT.com/RallyO/index.htm.
